Symbols are part of our everyday life. For centuries they've warned us of

danger and directed to food and shelter. As we create new technologies, we still

rely on the same five core shapes to create all of the communication we use

outside of a given alphabet. At the root of our world of symbols is an all but lost

history of origin.

The Absolute suite of paintings is an exploration into (at the moment) two

of these five core shapes; the line and circle. There's a journey of re-discovery

when you see real objects placed back into their meanings. Through these

pieces, I'm exploring how we find fixed positions in our lives regardless of the

relative contexts that are forced onto us. Like our ancestors, I am contextualizing

the elements in new ways to make entirely new meanings. In doing so, a new

relationship is created between two forces — two atmospheres, where one is

always subordinate to the other. The relationship and loving tension between

these two beliefs inform the entire situation, creating value as a whole that is

worth more than each part as an individual.

Finding the absolutes and their complements in life is about symmetry,

synchronicity, and balance--a life of geometry.
